The consent statement is as follows:

I hereby consent to receive electronically all notices of each and every kind from the National Environmental Health Association directed to the email address I provided [as my login address for the Association's website]. I acknowledge and agree that this consent to electronic transmission is broad and includes all notices provided by the Association for any reason. I agree all such notices may be sent to the email address listed above and that such notice will be effective for all purposes under applicable law and under the Association's governing documents. I agree to update that email address with the Association as changes occur in the future. I agree it is my responsibility to update my information with the Association. I understand that: A) upon written request, the Association will provide any particular notice on paper or in non-electronic form and B) I may withdraw this consent by providing written notice of such withdrawal to the Association.
