thought leadership, and crucial advocacy efforts. Now more than ever, your membership with NEHA offers unrivaled access to the community and resources needed to achieve your goals.

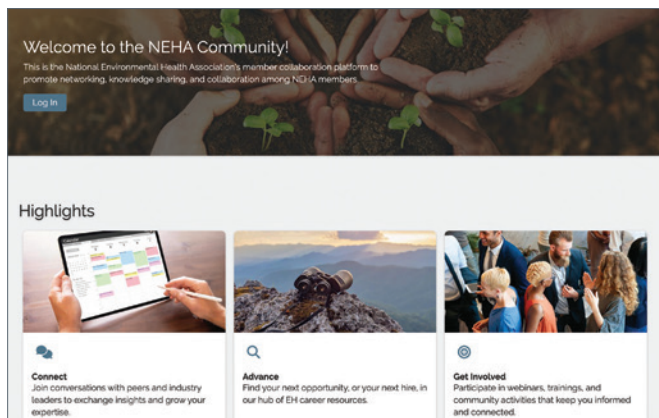
